PACE is a community development organization that creates economic solutions to meet the employment, education, housing, environmental, and business development challenges of low-income residents in disadvantaged communities throughout the greater Los Angeles area.

PACE Business was founded in the aftermath of the 1992 Los Angeles riots, when local small businesses suffered severe economic losses. Since then, the program has provided Small Business Counseling, Business Contracting Services, and Access to Capital.

WHO WE SERVE

PACE primarily serves communities facing systemic barriers: 82.5% of responding clients identify as ethnic minorities, and 94.0% are low-to-moderate income
